Due to limited supervision in the morning, please do not send your student to school before 7:45 a.m. All students who come to school before 8:00 a.m. must report to the Cafeteria. All meals are free to currently-enrolled Frontier students. For lunch, your child can bring food from home or eat the lunch provided by the cafeteria. Please note the following: Sharing food is strictly prohibited, do not send glass containers to school, and limit soda and sweets. Also, only people listed on a student's emergency contacts are permitted to deliver outside lunch to their child at school (No Door Dash, Uber Eats, etc.). All students are expected to leave campus promptly at the 2:57 p.m. dismissal time, unless arrangements have been made in advance.

We have a lot of fun family events planned for the year, and we always welcome volunteers to work with us in creating the best possible learning environment. You must have a Twin Rivers Volunteer Badge to volunteer at the school. We have opportunities for parents to serve on our School Site Council (SSC) or English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC) as well as helping your child's teacher.
